



A history as epic as the Panama Canal itself

By the time the SS Ancon passed through the Panama Canal – the first ship to do so – on August 15, 1914, the Canal had taken over 34 years to complete and had cost 30,000 lives. One of the world's great engineering feats, when completed it would save seafarers over the next 100 years some 8,000 miles per journey.

People had dreamed of connecting the Atlantic and Pacific via the Isthmus of Panama for centuries. A French company began digging around 1880, attempting a sea-level canal under the direction of Suez Canal mastermind Ferdinand de Lesseps. Led by President Theodore Roosevelt, the Americans took over with a plan of locks in 1904 that successfully connected the two oceans. More than 14,000 ships still pass through this 100-year-old marvel each year.
